# Melon Salsa

Makes 12 serving, 1/3 cup each  
15 Calories/Serving



**Ingredients:**

- 2 cups melon, honeydew, cantaloupe or watermelon, seeded and diced
- 1 cup cucumber, peeled, seeded and diced
- 1/4 cup onion, diced
- 2 tablespoons fresh cilantro, parsley or mint, minced
- 1 jalapeno, seeded and minced
- 1/4 cup lime or lemon juice
- 1 tablespoon sugar

**Directions:**

1. In a medium-sized bowl, stir together all ingredients.
2. Taste and season with more lemon or lime juice, and sugar if needed.
3. Cover and chill for at least 30 minutes.
4. Serve with grilled or broiled fish or chicken or with whole-grain tortilla chips.

**Tips:**

1. Use one type of melon or a combination to make this salsa.
2. When handling hot peppers, the oils can cause burning and skin irritation. Wear clean kitchen gloves or wash hands thoroughly after preparing.  
**KEEP HANDS AWAY FROM EYES.**
3. Pair this salsa with grilled fish, quinoa, steamed cauliflower and milk.
